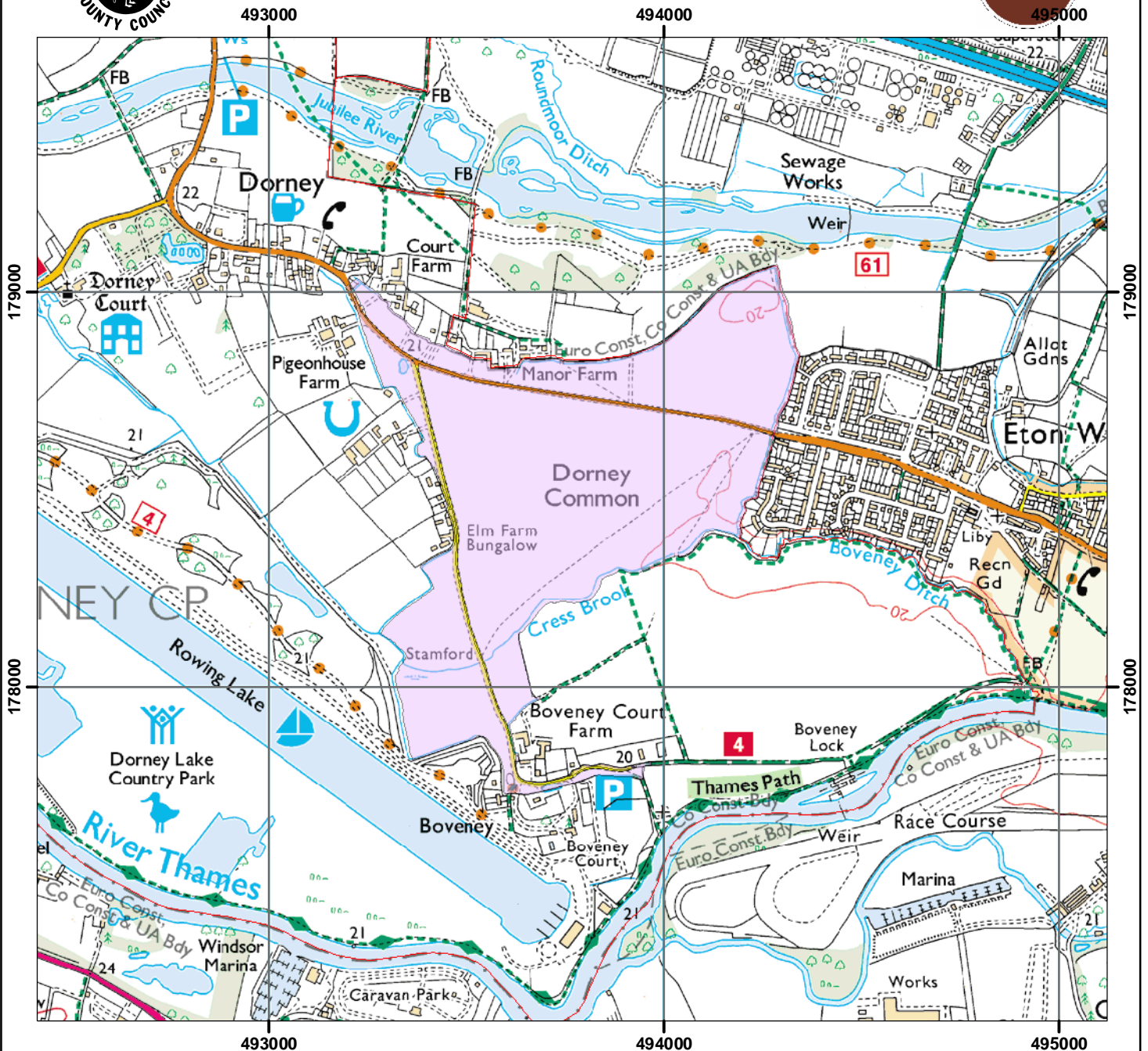

What you need to know

- You can do any recreational activities carried out on foot i.e. walking, sightseeing, bird-watching and running.
- There are some restrictions to limit where you can walk or take a dog, they MUST be kept on a lead of no more than 2m long between 1st March and 31st July or at any time of the year when livestock are present.

What not to do

- Camping, cycling, horse riding or driving a vehicle (except mobility scooters & buggies), but where these activities already take place - they are unaffected.
