Item We confirm all Orders to exclude foreigners cattle under ye severall penalties.

Item We Order that no person turn any Swine into the Common field till all Corn be carried out of the

field four days

Item We order that henceforth no one shall put into the Comon more hogs than Double ye Stint of his Neat Beasts which he might put in and all piggs shall be deemed as hogs which shall be pigged before May Day but all piggs after that Day shall not be accounted hogs till ye 25 of September following on penalty of One shilling per hog ye ffirst offence <sup>and</sup> 2s. 9d. ye Second <sup>and</sup> so toties Quoties

Item We order that all persons who hold more than <sup>10</sup> ~~50~~ <sup>per</sup> Annus shall either Stock their own Comons or lease them & neither lett or take any commons but such as appertain to their own farms on penalty <sup>of</sup> 5 ye first offence <sup>and</sup> so Toties Quoties but all persons who hold under <sup>10</sup> ~~50~~ <sup>per annum</sup> shall not lett any Comon but shall be allowed for all Comons Unstockt by a rate made on all Horses & Cows depastured in this <sup>e</sup> Comon and all poor Cottages who cannott stock their 2 cow Comons may hire in lieu of one of <sup>them</sup> ~~ye~~ one Milch Cow in ye Comon for their own use and the said Rule for ye Comons Unstockt shall be gathered by the Church Warden or Chappelwarden and all persons who Desire to be paid for their Comons Unstockt shall give an account to the Church or Chappellwarden of what Commons they will not Stock by April 25 and Receive their money ye last day of ye said month those who will not pay shall forfeit Double & ye Stewards Warrant to ye Churchwarden and Chappelwarden shall be sufficient to distrain on ye Goods or Chattels of such who refuse payment

Item We order that whosoever holds Gorges Orchard shall after Michas. next be lyable to bear office and Do-Suit and Service as tho' ye house formerly erected were still standing

Item We Order that all persons who shall hereafter  
 come to live in these premises with Certificate  
 shall not have any privilege of Comon or Comon field  
 of Dorney & Boveney but his cattle shall be deemed  
 as Trespassors or foreigners cattle if Depastured  
 in ye Comon or Comon field but we allow inhabitants  
 to enjoy Comons if they goe with a Certificate from  
 Boveney <sup>so</sup> & Dorney or

Item We Order that Hen. Messenger Depasture his Sheep  
 in Oak Stubs no further than ye part of ye *(yeld which*  
 lyes North east of ye highway leading from Lyards  
 Lays to Maidenhead on penalty of ten shillings *for*  
 Every offence against your order ~~We~~ all agree to  
<sup>orand</sup> Share by Wm. Griffin in ye execution of his office

Item We Order that ye Senr. foremen of each Jury set  
 out Lands in Dispute as occasion requires

And do hereby nominate the sd Wm. Griffin <sup>Hayward</sup>  
 and Do allow him for his salary two pence <sup>per annum</sup> for every  
 horse Depastured on ye Comon and One penny for every  
 Neat Beast and one penny for every Swine ye Account  
 to be taken ye 10th of September next and ye said  
 Hayward shall diligently see that ye Comon be not  
 dug up by the Hogs nor foreigners cattle Depastured  
 on ye Comon or Green but shall forthwith pound them  
 and if any swine be found unrung or Digging he shall  
 acquaint ye owner of it and if the said swine be not  
 Rung within 20 hours after such notice he shall  
 impound them and receive 3d per hog of ye Owner
