Item That whereas at the Court held at Dorney on
Monday the 26th day of October 1730 we the Parishoners
have thought fitt to present all persons that shall
neglect the Repairs of the Thames Banks after notice
given and all ffences whatsoever of other kinds to
be done forthwith and on twenty Days after ye date
hereof for the repairs of ye Thames banks on ye
forfeiture & penalty of \$5s. for every pole Gap or
Breach in ye said Bank if reported by 2 of ye Foremen
of ye Jury to be out of Repairs and if not immediately
then repaired to forfeit 10s per pole And so on till
repaired

Item We Order that henceforth none shall put into ye Comon more hogs than Double ye Stint of his Neat Beasts which he might put in and all piggs shall be deemed as hogs which shall be pigged before May Day but all piggs after that day shall not be accounted hogs till ye 25 of September following On penalty of One shilling ^{per} each hog ye first offence and 2s. ye second and so Toties Quoties

Item We Order that henceforth no foreigners cattle shall have any Comon of Pasture or Pasturage in ye Comon or Comon fields of Dorney or Boveney (A Bull being excepted) under ye Penalty of 5s. for ye first offence ^{and} 10s. ye 2nd So Toties Quoties And that no Bull Depastured on ye Common shall be sold or taken from ye Comon till 4 years old on penalty of 10s. except Adjudged by ye Churchwardens as Mischevious and Detrimentall to the inhabitants

ORDERED that Wm. Grover Thos. ffinch Michaell Clarke John Appleby, Richd. Seding Nath. Hunt Richd. Brothers Hen. Stevens foremen of each Jury do set out Lands between Lord & Tenant and Tenant and Tenant as Oft as occasion on Notice Given.

Trespass
Item We elect Henry Webb Heyward for ye year ensueing and allow him ^{per} 3d each horse and 2d for all Neat Beasts Depastured on ye Comon additionall to such gains as shall be had by Foreigners cattle and other cattle that are put on ye said Comon contrary to the orders of ye said Court also such cattle as are found trespassing In all such cases to impound the same and to receive for his ffee from ye Owners thereof ⁴d and ye Account to be taken ye fifth of August every year during his office and to be paid accordingly

Item We Order for ye better keeping such Neat Beasts

as have ~~the~~ Right only of Going in the Comon according to the Orders aforesaid and for a Better Certainty to the Heyward to ^{see} ~~he~~ who transgress ye said Order that all the sd Cattle be marked with ye Lord of ye Manors Mark otherwise to be reputed foreigners cattle or trespassing on ye said Comon and be had to pound in ye same manner as foreigners or trespassing cattle and ye said Heyward to receive the ffees accordingly and all ye said cattle aforesaid be marked on or before ye Six Day of May next.

ITEM We confirm all orders of Preceeding Courts as are not herein Inserted.

ITEM We Order that a rate of ye Stint of Neat Beasts and Horses that every Inhabitant of Dorney & Boveney aforesaid can or ought to keep in ye said Common as Ordered in the year 16³89 also in ye Year 1677 & 1693 be duely observed by the present Inhabitants of ye said Mannors which said Stint is signed by ye Steward of ye said Mannor and Ordered to be annexed to the Records of these Courts.

ITEM We present ye Death of Jno. Bannister and that there is due to ye Lord of these Mannors a years Quitt Rent for a Rellife

ITEM We present ye Death of Robt. Cook and that there is due to ye Lord of these Mannors a years Quitt Rent for a Rellife

ITEM We present ye Death of Jno. Dollin and that there is due to the Lord of these Mannors a Years Quitt Rent for a Rellife

At a court summoned to be held this day at the waggon and horses (not the manor house) in the parish of Hitcham for the manor of Hitcham ^{cum} ~~and~~ Dorney by Id. Grenville (being the first time he attempted to hold a court)
Frogatt steward

I Sir Charles Palmer appeared and protested against any jurisdiction or exercise of power by or on the part of any court held in the parish of Hitcham or in or concerning the Manor of Dorney cum Membris.

Date of rolls then produced

1725 1st roll Dorney cum Hitcham (the only one in latin)
-37 2nd do Hitcham cum Dorney (thus endeavouring to
-53 3rd do make Dorney a member of Hitcham instead of
-61 4th do Hitcham of Dorney)
-67 5th do

They alledged they had one between -67 & -80 but did not produce it

-80 Minutes only of court held of this date produced but said they had a roll somewhere.

The manor of Hitcham appears to be worth little having no copy-holders or quit rents of any consequence. The only jurisdiction they appeared to exercise near Dorney was by swearing in petty constables and tythingman. They summoned half their jury out of Dorney. To these mem:
