

## Key Events and Issues in Dorney Parish in 2012

The year 2012 was a momentous one for Dorney Parish, dominated by the **London 2012 Olympic and Paralympic Games** held at Dorney Lake. The Games brought a mix of excitement, disruption, and lasting impacts on the village. - **Traffic Management and Parking Restrictions:** The prospect of up to 30,000 spectators per day during the Olympic rowing and canoe sprint events at Dorney Lake prompted significant traffic management and parking plans.
  - These plans, while intended to ensure safety and security, caused concern among residents about potential disruption to their daily lives.
  - The implementation of parking permits for residents and visitors and the designation of "no stopping" zones on key roads were key elements of the traffic management scheme.
- **The Dorney Roar and Community Spirit:** Despite some initial anxieties, the Games themselves brought a surge of community spirit and pride to Dorney.
  - Residents embraced the opportunity to witness history firsthand, with many describing the atmosphere at Dorney Lake as electric.
  - Nick Teale's account of attending the Olympic rowing events with his wife highlights the excitement and sense of occasion that the Games generated.
- **Olympic Legacy: Mixed Feelings and Uncertainties:** In the aftermath of the Games, residents expressed mixed feelings about the Olympic legacy for Dorney.
  - While the rowing venue remained a world-class facility, there was a sense of disappointment that the promised wider benefits, such as improved broadband connectivity, had not materialised.
  - The Parish Council's efforts to secure "legacy name signs" acknowledging Dorney's role as an Olympic host were initially unsuccessful.

### Beyond the Games: Life in Dorney Parish in 2012

- **Dorney & District Horticultural Society: A Flourishing Community:** The Dorney & District Horticultural Society (DDHS) played a vital role in village life, celebrating its 59th year in 2012.
  - The society organised events like the Annual Horticultural Show, coach trips to notable gardens, and social gatherings.

- These activities fostered a sense of community, showcased residents' talents, and contributed to Dorney's entry in the Buckinghamshire Best Kept Village competition.
- **Village Hall Refurbishment: A Project in the Making:** The need to refurbish the Dorney Village Hall was a recurring theme in 2012.
  - The Parish Council minutes reveal discussions about the feasibility of the project and the challenges of securing funding.
- **Broadband: A Persistent Issue:** Residents frequently expressed frustration with the slow and unreliable broadband speeds in Dorney.
  - The hope that the Olympics would bring improvements was largely dashed, although efforts were underway to register interest in BT Infinity (fiber-optic broadband) in the hope of prompting faster rollout.
- **Traffic and Parking: Ongoing Concerns:** Traffic congestion and inconsiderate parking were recurring issues throughout the year, particularly on roads leading to Dorney Lake.
  - The Parish Council and the local Neighbourhood Policing Team grappled with these problems, exploring solutions such as increased police patrols, parking restrictions, and potential infrastructure improvements.
